New York

US Route 219 SEIS Funding – Advocate the restoration of \$6.7 million for the Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS). The SEIS must be completed prior to constructing any piece of the remaining 20 miles from Springville to Interstate 86 in Salamanca.

Pennsylvania

McKean County – Engage the public, public officials, Route 219 Association, PENNDOT and North Central PA Regional Planning and Development Commission in a collaborative initiative to identify and improve safety, access and mobility trouble spots south of Bradford

Elk County to Cambria County – Activate stakeholder groups through the introduction and establishment of Route 219 committees in additional Pennsylvania communities along the corridor to complement Route 219 associations in Cattaraugus (NY) and McKean (PA) Counties

Somerset to Meyersdale – Continue to advocate and publicize the ongoing construction of the 11-mile section of new highway from Somerset to Meyersdale.

Pennsylvania and Maryland

Meyersdale, PA to I-68 and Grantsville, MD – Advocate the completion of the US 219-019 Project Planning Study to further the 9.5-mile, four-lane, limited access highway project from the Meyersdale Bypass to I-68 and Grantsville, MD
